- Detailed report for January was distributed prior to the meeting for review and to allow for effective discussion at the Board meeting
- A/S/Stg Andrew MacIsaac provided a comprehensive overview and explanation of the report
- Main focus lately was the train derailment in Goderich
- During the month of January there were 6 RIDE programs conducted in South Huron
- 13 mental health calls were attended to in January
- South Huron had no calls for service related to COVID-19 this past month
- Significant drug bust in Exeter drug trafficking investigation seized various drugs and paraphernalia numerous charges were laid
- Investigation of this magnitude takes significant time and resources for successful sentencing solid charges and happy with results
- Foot patrols have been conducted by officers during the early morning hours
- School resource officer will be fully engaged next week when the youngsters return to school
- Overview of the media releases was provided to the Board
- There was a Focused Patrol at the intersection of Dashwood Road and Airport Line engaged traffic team from London to assist poor driving habits were reported due to construction at this intersection
- Upon investigation, the stop sign is not the issue speed coming out of Exeter has been identified as the problem
- Posted signage increasing the speed limit exiting Exeter has been moved past Airport Line on Dashwood Road
- Rumble strips have been installed on Airport Line and have been found to be very effective and working well
- 12 hours of officer time was dedicated to this intersection in January
- Theft due to unlocked vehicles and keys left in the vehicles continues to be an ongoing problem very frustrating and time consuming to investigate
- Preventative measure remove your keys and lock your vehicle
- Suggest messaging on Municipal website, continuing to creating education and awareness

- Dietrich noted that Huron County is a large area to cover and priority calls are necessary for effective service delivery
- Chair Dietrich thanked A/S/Sgt MacIsaac for providing the overview and explanation to the Board membership
